

# Extension Exhibits 2025

## HOME DIVISION



Mayfield KY, 42066

1. All entries to be entered on **Tuesday, June 10th**, between the hours of 9:00am-11:00am at the Expo 1 building at the Graves County fairgrounds, 1004 KY-121, Mayfield. All entries must be removed **Friday, June 13th**, between 8:30am-4:30pm at the Graves County Cooperative Extension Service, 4200 State route 45 N, Mayfield. Checks for premium money will be mailed within two weeks from the fair board.
2. Judging of exhibits will be **Tuesday, June 10th**. Only workers and judges will be allowed in the Home Division section during judging. Viewing of entries will take place Tuesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> from 5-7pm in the Expo 1 building at the fairgrounds. Exhibits will then be moved to the Graves County Extension Office for viewing until the Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup> pick up.
3. Exhibitors must be at least 18 years old.
4. All articles in the Home Division must be handmade and completed within 3 years prior to this year's Fair to be eligible for entrance in this department and must have been work of the exhibitor.
5. All exhibits must be clean, or they will not be judged.
6. All professional or foreign work will be barred in this department. One who derives a major part of income from the type of work being exhibited by them is considered a professional in this department.
7. Judges may, at their discretion, award a ribbon of such grade as the article deserves.
8. **EXHIBITORS** must determine the appropriate class for their entry. Any article not up to standard in the class in which it is exhibited can be disqualified by the judge. Any entry must remain in the category determined by the **EXHIBITOR**.
9. No exhibitor will be allowed to exhibit more than one article in any one class.
10. Family member(s) cannot enter "like" items.
11. If there is more than one article in any exhibit (such as towels, table mats, etc.) they should be fastened together securely.
12. The management will not be responsible for any article exhibited, but due care and diligence will be given in the handling of articles.
13. The Fair will not act as a selling agency. No articles can be shown in the department with a "For Sale" tag or name of exhibitor attached. Any sales must be between the owner and the prospective purchaser. The superintendent of the department will be glad to give name and address of owner.
14. No pictures accepted unless framed and/or fixed for hanging.
15. We will not be responsible for exhibits not picked up by 4:30p.m. on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
