A note from Debbie Smith, Graves County Homemaker President

Happy New Year! I hope everyone had a very merry Christmas and you are ready for a great New Year! Even though our "year" begins in July, it's never too late to set goals. One way to set goals is to use the "SMART" method; let's see if we can make that work for us.

S—Specific—Make your goal specific and narrow for more effective planning. For us, our goal might be to make sure we attend each club meeting. Or it may be that we would choose a role where we can help our local or county club more. For example, if there is a leadership or office opening, we may make it our goal to fill that opening.

M—Measurable—Make sure your goal and progress are measurable. Set an outcome for your goal. I find we can measure our goals better if we write them down. "I am going to attend all meetings this year." If you write it down, then you can check yourself, as time goes on, to see if you meet the goal each month.

A—Achievable—Make sure you can reasonably accomplish your goal within a certain time frame. If you set the goal of being present at all meetings, but you know that every other month you have a conflict where you can't attend, that goal may not be achievable. Choose another goal instead. Maybe you will set the goal of keeping up to date on the KEHA website each month. Or if you are an Education Chairman, you might set the goal of stressing one part of your Program of Work each month to your club.

R—Relevant—Your goal should align with your values and long-term objectives. We need to make sure our goal is relevant to KEHA. If you set a goal of learning one new fact a week, that may not be relevant to homemakers. But, if you are an education chairman, you might set a goal of sharing one part of your Program of Work.

T—Time-based—Set a realistic, but ambitious, end date to clarify task prioritization and increase motivation. Of course, KEHA has its own end date, July 1. But perhaps your goal was to become an officer for your club or for the county. Our county has a three-year limit with an additional three years if the person agrees to serve. If we stick by these limits, we do not "overwork" any one person.

I know this is a much different article than I usually write, but I think sometimes we need to see what research tells us work! We have many opportunities for you to be an active part of GCEH. There will be county offices coming up soon that will need someone to volunteer. We need members to step up to present the monthly lessons. We can use volunteers when we have catering opportunities. We need members to help at Taste of Graves County (and wow did we have members step up this year!). So, there's no end to "jobs" available on our local level.

Maybe as you are setting your own personal goals, you might look at setting Homemaker goals, too. Again, Happy 2024!!! May this be our best year ever.
